Thessaloniki, the capital of Macedonia Prefecture is the second largest city of Greece (after Athens). In fact, the city is honorality called co-capital for its historical and administrative inportance.

Thessaloniki is a modern city that restored most of its wounds and receives millions of visitors every year. With the population of about 800.000 people, Thessaloniki is famous for its ancient monuments and vivid nightlife. The trademark of Thessaloniki is the White Tower, right in the waterfront. It was built in the 16th century by the Ottomans and along its history it was used as a fort, a prison, a meteorology laboratory and today it houses the Byzantine Museum of the town.

Two big Universities are located in the city "Aristoteles University" and "University of Macedonia" and one big "Technological Institution". That's why Thessaloniki is a very lively city, full of young people.

Useful Information



Travel cost reimbursement:

The nearest airport is this of Thessaloniki - Makedonia airport (SKG)
Volunteers will be reimbursed for their tickets (airplane, train, bus), both ways, according to the Distance Calculator of the E.U.

Accommodation:

Volunteers will stay in an apartment that has 3 bedrooms, bathroom, kitchen. It will be equipped to meet the basic needs of the volunteer himself to live there with dignity. Additional equipment can be added on request and deemed necessary.



Alimentation & Pocket money:

Volunteers will monthly receive 140 EUR for food and 6 EUR pocket money per day.



Medical coverage:

As Hosting organization we ensure that:

- The volunteer is insured by the insurance company of ESC program. The procedure has
 to be made by the sending organization.
- And further provided that the conditions hold the European Health Insurance Card.

In Thessaloniki there are 10 public hospitals.



Training:

Volunteers will take part in on-arrival and mid-term trainings, organized by the National Agency. Additionally there will be internal trainings if need for any position.



Mentor:

The Mentor will support the volunteers in every stage of their ESC project and will make sure that they will get the resources and tools needed to accomplish their tasks but also for their personal needs. For this reasons mentor will have regular meetings with the volunteers every week.
